

## Rules for HFM Internal Competitions

The various internal competitions form an important part of our programme. They enable members to learn from those who excel, from mistakes of themselves and others and to entertain the members.

These competitions have their own rules and, for the benefit of new and old members, the most relevant of these are as follows:

The movies submitted must have been completed within the previous two years of the particular competition, and should comply with HFM Competition Rules. The entrant must have been fully responsible for all aspects of the making of the movie and must have been the prime person in direct control of all stages of the production and completion.

Entries exceeding 15 minutes in length will not be accepted unless, considering the other videos submitted, and in the judgement of the Competition Secretary there is enough time for the video to be shown. This would allow longer videos to be shown in the less popular competitions such as nature and documentary. All movies should have 10 seconds of black at the start and end.

Details of the entry in accordance with the rules must be given to the Competitions Secretary by the specified date before the particular competition.
