# Treasurer's Report for the year ended 30th April 2019

Despite some cost saving measures we still ended up with a deficit of £631. This was mainly due that we have had no other source of income , apart from a reduced amount of Subscription.

## Significant changes between 2018 and 2019 in Receipts and Payments:

### Where receipts were less in 2019 than in 2018 by:

Subscriptions £75 Fewer members.

**Tax Rebate: £149** I still expect to receive this rebate soon as I had some login in problems in claiming the rebate which was only resolved towards he end of April.

**Equipment Hire: £300** We received no requests to project videos of other parties which we could fulfil.

**Donations: £106**, Unfortunately, Aivar was not able to continue selling donated equipment to the public.

**Public shows: £43** This year it was decided not to have Public Shows, mainly because there were not enough videos to show.

Where payments were less in 2019 than in 2018 by:

**Programme costs: £40** Fewer Gifts of appreciation to outside speakers.

**<u>Christmas Party: £227</u>** No Party held this year for various reasons.

**New Equipment: £845** This year only a Blur-Ray player was bought compared to a laptop for £900 IN 2018.

### Where payments were more in 2019 than in 2018:

### Room rent: £66

**<u>Competitions: £73</u>** Mainly money spent on plaques and engravings for trophies handed to competition winners.

I recommend that the annual subscription should remain £35 for the next year beginning on September1 2019.

Finally, there is a cash balance of **£2,974** which is **£631** less than at the end of last year.
